Appointment of permanent Headteacher for Sidlesham Primary School Message to Parents from Chair of Governors

Our governing body has been engaged since the beginning of January in the process of recruiting a new permanent Headteacher for our little school. As we reach the conclusion of this process my fellow Governors and I would like to recognise the support we have received from all our staff and pupils. We must also recognise the involvement of each child, they have met, and on occasion, engaged, with nine potential applicants. All our potential applicants when visiting the school commented upon the children's good behaviour and politeness.

During the final stages we employed members of the School Council to convene an interview panel for our shortlisted candidates. They prepared questions which they then went on to ask the candidates. After the interviews they deliberated with our recruitment panel and provided feedback essential to the process.

We can today announce that we have appointed an excellent Headteacher to continue to lead the school forward. At this time we are unable to provide any further details as we collaborate with another school to coordinate the communication of the announcement. We hope to bring you more news shortly and are conscious that you have all been very patient.
