Child related safeguarding or child protection concern:

- 1. Listen to the child, do not promise confidentiality or ask leading questions.
- 2. Make detailed notes at the time/immediately afterwards; record the date, time, place and context of disclosure or concern. Use Initial Record of Safeguarding Concern Form/CPOMS if you have access.
- 3. Record facts (child's words) but not your assumption or interpretation. Record if anyone else was present. In the case of an injury record the detail, e.g. "right arm above elbow" and use body maps.
- 4. Discuss your concerns with the DSL and in their absence, one of the DDSLs.
