

Dinosaur Roar!

English – We will be focussing mainly on 2 key texts, The Girl and the Dinosaur and Nibbles; The Dinosaur Guide. We will be writing information texts about different types of dinosaur and our own dinosaur stories. In guided reading we will be looking at all sorts of stories and rhymes about dinosaurs.

Year 1 will be continuing to learn the alternative pronunciation of sounds in phase 5 phonics

Year 2 will be looking at adding suffixes to words such as ment, ful, ness as well as how to use apostrophes

DT – We will be making a moving picture of a dinosaur investigating how to use moving parts as well as cutting and joining materials.



Geography – We will look at where in the world evidence of dinosaurs has been found. We will be learning to name the 5 continents of the world and locating them on a world map. We will also look at the Jurassic Coast and learn about Mary Anning.



History – We will be discussing how we use evidence to find out about the dinosaurs as they lived in the past.

Science – We will be continuing to look at living things and learning how to classify creatures by their characteristics. We will be focussing on the skeletons of dinosaurs and naming parts of them. We will also be continuing to observe the changes in the weather and the seasons

PE – In our indoor and outdoor PE sessions we will be focussing on athletics and dance.

Maths – We will be continuing to focus on developing our mental maths skills

- Doubling and halving numbers to 10
- Counting in 2s 5s and 10s

Year 2 will be beginning to learn their 2s and 10 times tables.

We will be focussing on learning a range of methods to add and subtract numbers efficiently using different representations, such as number lines.

We will be starting to look at telling the time.

Year 1 – to the hour and half hour
Year 2 – identifying quarter past

PSHE – we will be looking at change and how things have changed for us and changes that will be happening at school and at home as we grow older.
